Compliance is achieved through close cooperation with global supply chain stakeholders such as importers, carriers, consolidators, licensed customs brokers, and manufacturers.

In achieving CTPAT certification, we maintain a documented process for identifying and alleviating risk throughout our customers’ global supply chains. OIA Global conducts the [CTPAT Five Step Risk Assessment Protocol](#) annually, unique to our business model and services. This includes physical & cargo security vetting, known shipper verification, denied parties screening, GDPR compliance, general data security and cybersecurity management.

The security and protection of global supply chains is fully supported by OIA Global’s executive leadership. All employees, contractors, service providers, and visitors are expected to adhere to CTPAT security policies and procedures for the smooth, continuous flow of safe, secure, and punctual cargo.
